**Event is rain or shine.** In the event the Fest is cancelled, Youth on the Ridge Community Foundation Inc. will be responsible to refund prepaid space fee and has no other liabilities with regard to this event.

Sellers are required to provide their own canopies/tents, dividers, tables, chairs, trash receptacle, and to take all your trash with you. No Styrofoam is allowed. Booth space is 10' x 10'.

Infrastructure set-up for the festival will be permitted on Friday, May 10th, between 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. Set-up must be completed by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 11th. Security will be provided on Friday night. The hours for the festival are Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. No early tear-down.

Exhibitors will be advised by Email of their acceptance to the festival within 2 weeks of receipt of completed application & full payment. Exhibitor's packets will be sent to vendors no later than 1 week before the festival.
